Highway Obstructions

*****Pushing snow or other materials onto or across roads from private driveways is dangerous and prohibited. Doing so may create potential safety concerns for traveling public and may impede the snow and ice removal process. We really need to improve on this – it's a very serious matter.**
Do NOT push snow to ends of culverts – this causes plugging of culverts and you will be charged for damages to road/culverts***

Update on ATV/UTV traffic

The Town of Cassel roads are NOT open to ATV/UTV traffic as of right now. At the October board meeting the town board did approve opening all Town of Cassel roads (not highways) to ATV/UTV traffic. A town ordinance needs to be published and proper signage needs to be placed before roads will be open.

Anticipated date will be Spring of 2021.

Update on Town-wide Garbage and Recycling pickup

The Town Board has looked into town-wide garbage and recycling pickup for the past few years. As a part of exploring that option, the Board sent out a postcard questionnaire. We had a remarkable response rate, with the majority of those responding saying they wanted to have town-wide garbage and recycling collection. The next step is to issue a request for bid in order to evaluate pricing.

The time is now for the Board to move forward with doing so, because our contract with Waste Management for our recycling dumpsters at the Town Hall, expires March 31, 2021. Because this service will be town-wide, we expect to receive an exceptional rate, similar to what our neighbors in the Town of Emmet received in 2017 when they went with a town-wide system. Please keep in mind the soonest this would take place would be April 1, 2021.

In person absentee voting is available through November 1st – please call the Clerk for an appointment, 715-573-3862 – PHOTO ID is required. Curbside voting is available.

If you have already requested an absentee ballot, please remember if not returned back to the clerk by November 3, 2020 at 8 pm your vote will not be counted. Please allow 5-7 days if you are mailing your ballot. You may also drop your completed ballot at the Town Hall the day of the election or call the clerk to make an appointment to drop off between now and November 3rd.
